

MOD SHOEBURYNESS RECREATIONAL SHOOTING REQUIREMENTS

QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

What is Recreational Shooting?

Recreational shooting is the collective term used to describe non-operational shooting on MOD Shoeburyness including Game, Wildfowl and Clay Pigeon for pastime and/or commercial gain. The following details the rules and process which **MUST** be followed by all MOD tenants/approved organisations that are licensed, or have the right to conduct recreational shooting on any part of the Range. Pest Control is **not** considered to be recreational shooting and is subject to different rules and process (see main policy document).

This quick-reference guide is comprised of extracts from the document 'MOD Shoeburyness – Rules for Non-operational Shooting, SHB/NONOPSHOOTINGPOLICY/002/0523, May 2023' and should be used in conjunction with the overarching policy document.

When is Recreational Shooting not permitted to take place?

For reasons of Health and Safety, recreational shooting (of any type) is **NOT** permitted to take place on weekdays (Mon to Fri). See Exemptions below.

- Friday afternoons: recreational shooting is permitted on Friday afternoons when QinetiQ has ceased
 all activity (this is defined as a time when all live activity and ammunition movements around the site
 have ceased). Permission to open fire on a Friday afternoon must be obtained from Range Control
 which will only give that assent when all QinetiQ personnel are out of pre-informed shoot areas.
- Public Holidays (England): recreational shooting is permitted on Public Holidays and other days when
 the Range is closed for mandated holidays (i.e. between Christmas and New Year). Any shoots
 requested for these days will be treated as organised recreational shoots and will be subject to all of the
 requirements detailed in this and the overarching policy document.
